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**Evaluation Methods Used:** Testing was done on Google Chrome v119.0, various Google Chrome extensions such as <u>WCAG</u> <u>Color contrast checker</u> and <u>Landmark Navigation via Keyboard or Pop-up</u> and macOS Sonoma with Apple's accessibility options such as VoiceOver, zooming, invert colors, use grayscale, color settings, contrast settings and transparency settings.
